JACOB ALLION is a native of Baden, Germany, and was born March 5, 1810. His parents, Jacob and Catharine (Denninger) Allion, were also natives of Germany, and had four children, our subject being the only surviving. His mother died in her native country, his father in Lucas County, Ohio in 1868. Mr. Allion emigrated to the United States and located in Franklin County, PA in 1832. He came to Ohio, and located in Richland County, moving to this (Wyandot) county in 1838. He purchased land in this township, and has since given his attention to farming, though a blacksmith by trade. He was married, January 12, 1837, to Christina Zupp, a native, of Germany, resident of Richland County, Ohio, and daughter of Peter and Maria Zupp, who were natives of France. They emigrated to the United States in an early day and settled first in Lancaster, Penn., moving from that point to Ohio, and later to Michigan. Mr. and Mrs. Allion had seven children, of whom but four survive, namely, Jacob, Elizabeth, Marie and Madaline. Mr. Allion has 200 acres of land well stocked and improved. He is a Democrat, and, with Mrs. Allion, a member of the Lutheran Church.

Zupp was born in Lancaster County, Pa., and when he was 3 years old they went to Wyandot County, Ohio. Three years later, they moved to Hillsdale County, Michigan. At the opening of the Civil War, he enlisted in the Eighteenth Michigan Infantry. After its close, he returned to Michigan, and moved to Buchanan County, Iowa. In 1869, he moved to Section 3, Douglas Township, Ida County, Iowa. At the time of 1869, Ida County cast only 32 votes, and only 3 families resided in Douglas Township. The Judge John H. Moorehead lived at the west edge of where Ida Grove was built later, and there were no homes between Mr. Zupp's farm in Douglas Township and Mr. Moorehead's home. The hardships experienced with pioneer life was common then.

Mr. Zupp, at the age of 19, first married Jennie Crawfoot, a native of New York, and a daughter of Seth and Ann Eliza Crawfoot. To this union was born two children: A. D. and Ida. In 1867, Mr. Zupp was united in marriage with Julia Crawfoot, a sister of his former wife, and they had the following children: Jennie (wife of M. G. Sherman of Cushing, Ia); Jessie; Will; Blanche (wife of Charles Herrington); Belle (Mrs. Mertell); and Pearl. The wife and mother died in 1883.

George Peter Zupp, the father of C. C. Zupp, was a veterinary surgeon by profession, and was a soldier under Napoleon Bonaparte, also in the Mexican War. He and his wife, Elizabeth, had 8 children: C. C. Zupp; George P., W. Z.; Christiana; Margaret; Caroline; Henry; and John.

There is no record of "Christopher Columbus Zupp" in anything discovered. There is no record of him as a Civil War soldier in the government records. Most of his claims can be attributed to his brother, John, who died at Lexington, KY in 1862. Chris was married to his first wife and in Iowa at that time.

Jennie Sherman, Ida County's Oldest Pioneer Woman, Called to Rest

WASHTA - On May 18, 1863, Julia and Christopher Zupp welcomed to their home a second daughter. They named her Mary Jane. It was a log cabin home - a pioneer home near Independence in Buchanan county, rich in love and friendly ties. She was one of a family of eight children and came to Ida county with her family in 1869 at the age of six years. She was a resident of this county for 71 years.

A child of the pioneers, she made the journey in a covered wagon drawn by oxen and lived to see the development of towns and cities in the new land, and wild prairies changed to cultivated fields. As a school girl, first in a dug-out, later in the "little red school house", she experienced the early blizzards of this region, saw the breaking plows at work, and watched the building of the first cabins and schools. Those early days were hard days but youth is ever triumphant. With her sisters she loved to roam over Iowa hillsides. Through the years these sisters continued the companionship of their childhood, through picnics, house parties and other good times together, always remembering the early days.

In 1883 Merritt George Sherman came to Ida county to build another pioneer home. To this house he brought his bride, Mary Jane Zupp, after their marriage December 19, 1885. To this union one child was born - a daughter, Mable. Since the death of Merritt George Sherman June 28, 1924, this daughter has remained the consistent and loving companion of her mother.

Jennie Sherman, as she was known to her many friends, was a sensitive and gentle woman, a loving wife and mother, always loyal to her neighbors, always helpful and kindly to all, an example of the finest type of womanhood. A charter member of the Washta Literary Club, she helped in the building of that splendid organization of progressive women, and was influential in creating the beautiful park in Washta. This spring she was lovingly appointed representative pioneer woman of the group, an honor given her by the unanimous approval of the members.

Only ten days before her sudden passing on Thursday, May 16, 1940, she attended a gathering of the literary club, and her presence will long be remembered in that friendly circle. On the day of her death Mrs. Sherman had been listening to the radio and had just told her sister, Mrs. Charles Conley, that she would read the paper awhile before retiring. When her sister returned, she found Mrs. Sherman, dead, evidently a heart attack.

All through the years Jennie Sherman was forever young. She was of the community and for the community. Often frail health caused her to spend her winters in the sunny land of Florida but when spring came her thoughts were for Iowa because her heart was there. This spring, with her daughter Mable, she returned again to her beloved home to its wide lawns and spacious rooms. She came with high hopes and plans; but the story of her life had been written.

Mrs. Jennie Sherman was a member of Washta Federated Church, Order of the Eastern Star, Rebekah Lodge and the Women's Literary Club of Washta.

She leaves to revere her memory her daughter, Mable, three sisters, Mrs. C.J. Beazley, Mrs. Soren Myrtue, Mrs. Charles Conley and one brother, A.D. Zupp, and other relatives and friends.

MERRITT G. SHERMAN

Merritt G. Sherman, who since 1904 has been connected with financial interests of Cherokee county, rising by the force of his ability and energy to be president of the Farmers State Bank of Washta, was born in Fremont county, this state, September 21, 1858. He is a son of Byron and Catherine (Wilson) Sherman, natives of New York state, whence

they afterward moved to Michigan. The father farmed there and later went to Fremont county, Iowa, where in 1853 he purchased government land at one dollar and seventy-five cents per acre. For thirty years thereafter he remained connected with agricultural interests of that locality, owning and operating the same farm. At the end of that time he disposed of his holdings and retired from active life, moving to Tampa, Florida, where he resided until his death, which occurred in March, 1905. His wife survives him and makes her home in Tampa.

Merritt G. Sherman was reared and educated in Fremont county and remained with his parents until he was twenty-one years of age. He then rented land which he operated for four years, after which he moved to Ida county, this state, buying six hundred and forty acres on section 13, Douglas township. This farm he operated until February, 1901, when he rented his property and moved into Washta, where for three years thereafter he gave his attention solely to the supervision of his property interests.
